AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR SPARSHOLT

Winchester City Council is proposing to develop a small number of Council homes at Woodman Close/Bostock Close.

A public consultation took place on Saturday 16th June at Sparsholt Memorial Hall to allow local residents to view the options for new affordable housing. The Council will consider comments made and a second consultation event will take place in Autumn 2018 presenting detailed proposals.
