### Highways – Stewart Wooles

**Flooding at The Plough** - The issue with the drains at the junction of Woodman Lane and Watley Lane causing flooding near The Plough has not yet been resolved. The recent rain, once again caused significant and dangerous flooding across the whole of Woodman Lane. A gully sucker was deployed and this cleared the water in the road. No action has yet to be taken to address the blockage in the drains that was identified and mentioned in my previous Highways Report.

We would much appreciate the intervention of Phil Bailey our Hampshire County Councillor to expedite this work and also the removal of the fallen tree at the back of the balancing pond.

**Potholes** – Although we have not had a particularly cold winter, the high rainfall has, inevitably, caused some road surfaces to break up and over time cause potholes.
