Flooding at the Plough:

The work to replace the blocked drain that feeds surface water from the road to the balancing pond was carried out in October. Since then there have been three periods of heavy rain fall none of which has caused the road flood.

I would now like to thank Phil Bailey, our HCC councillor, for his advice and support in resolving this long running road safety issue.

Give Way sign at B3049/Woodman Lane junction: The sign, which was located some 75m from the junction, "disappeared" during the summer. It was reported to HCC some 3 months ago, but no response has been received.

As there have been several RTAs on this junction, it is important that the sign is replaced and we will ask our HCC councillor to address this issue.
