The Emergency Plan for Sparsholt Parish allows volunteers from the parish to assist the emergency services in the event of a significant incident in our area. Such incidents might include accidents, weather-related emergencies or longer-term loss of power and/or water.

This leaflet tells you who to contact and what to do in the event of a serious incident in the parish.

It provides contacts for the Parish and your Local Responder. These volunteers can initiate the Parish Community Emergency Plan where necessary.

How to Help

This document also provides contact numbers for other services that may be required to assist or to help with household problems.

- ! When calling for assistance give clear, concise information as soon as possible.
- ! Assess the situation and provide the precise location of the incident and an indication of any casualties or damage.
- ! Remember, the person on the other end of the phone may not have personal knowledge of the local area.

Gather information for the emergency services

After contacting someone from the list opposite remain on the scene and assess the number and condition of casualties; any vehicles involved; major damage to buildings; blocked roads or a fire hazard.

Avoid placing yourself in danger. Until the emergency services arrive and only if you feel capable and it is safe to do so, assist with controlling traffic and people. Give first aid only if you are trained to do so.

Defibrillator

The parish defibrillator is located at the entrance to the Sparsholt Memorial Hall.

The code to open the box will be provided by the 999 operator who can contact local people trained in its use. Full instructions are also given by the defibrillators when switched on.

Consider being trained in the use of the defibrillator. Free training sessions are organised occasionally by the Parish Council.
