## Results of Survey of Traffic Speed and Volume through the Village

At the Parish Council's request HCC traffic management engineers have recently surveyed traffic volumes and speeds through the village at two points:

Adjacent post office: Westbound 22.0mph. Eastbound: 19.3mph

5 day average numbers 708. 7 day average numbers 640

South of Woodman Close: Northbound 27.3mph. Southbound 27.8mph 5 day average numbers 518. 7 day average numbers 456

Whilst there are large volumes of vehicles through the village there is generally good compliance with the speed limit.

There is further information to come once the data has been analysed more fully. In addition the school travel policy is being worked on by the school and WCC travel team and discussions are ongoing with Sparsholt College about the traffic issues the college creates.
