RENEWABLE ENERGY AT SPARSHOLT COLLEGE

It is understood that Winchester City Council's Planning Committee will be considering Ecotricity's resubmission of its planning application for an Anaerobic Digester and Education Building at Sparsholt College on the morning of 13th October. Members of the public are welcome to attend this meeting.

TREES AND HEDGES – A REMINDER

Trees close to roads need to be managed to make sure that they do not cause danger to people, vehicles, and neighbouring properties. Hampshire County Council manages trees growing on highway land. That means trees on public roads and pathways and generally (but not always) the verges beside them.

Hampshire County Council does not manage trees on private property and roads – **the land owner or occupier is responsible for these trees**. If trees are not the responsibility of Hampshire Highways, it may be able to give notice to the owner or occupier of the land to take the necessary action.

HOUSEHOLD WASTE RECYCLING CENTRES

Hampshire's Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs) will be introducing a charge for soil and rubble, plasterboard and asbestos from 1st October 2016. Soil and rubble, which is usually created from construction, alteration or repair of homes and gardens, will be charged at £2.50 per part or whole 30 litre bag, or per item.

From 1st January 2017 all HWRCs will open at 11am and will be closed on Thursdays.
