Traffic report

Cllr Walthoe received the draft proposal plans and a summary of the scheme costing from Alistair Macadam - Traffic Engineer, these were circulated prior to the meeting.

This project is no not yet ready for discussion, there are many questions that need addressing including the charge to replace the damaged bollards on Woodman Lane. It was decided to set up a team to form a fully costed proposal for presentation to the finance subcommittee and then to all Councillors at the June meeting.

20 mph limit

No financial assistance is available from HCC with the full cost would probably having to be found from parish council resources. Cllr Walthoe is to obtain quotes from HCC. Should the 20mph signs be pursued the parish council would look for grants and make a bid for ClL money from the Alfred Homes development. A residents meeting to consult on the 20mph issue and decide how long the stretch of road is to be covered by the 20mph would need to be held. Cllr Godfrey said that HCC are happy to support 20mph signs as long if it can be demonstrated that the local community are in favour.
